GSM TIP OF THE MONTH - APRIL

Where to play the ball in your stance. (This article is written from the right hand perspective).

Firstly, any shot that is played from the fairway, regardless of what club you are using, you should play the ball from the middle of your stance.

Secondly, any shot that is played from a tee you should move the ball to your left in your stance.

I base my reasoning on the fact that the golf swing is basically a "U" shape, much like a child on a skate board ramp. Where on the ramp is the child travelling at its fastest point? The bottom

Where is the bottom of the golf swing? The middle of your stance. Therefore this is the best place to play your shots from the fairway.

When it comes to hitting a shot from a tee, it must be slightly different. If you tee the ball up in the middle of your stance your club would get right under the ball and sky it. To prevent this from happening you move the ball toward your left heel so your club can make good contact with the ball. The higher you tee the ball the closer to your left heel you place the ball. The lower you tee the ball the closer to the middle of your stance your ball should be.

This should help you to hit crisper shots on and off the tee.... **Rob Williamson (PGA Teaching Professional)**
